

# Game Rules

---

1. Scramble format will be used. All players will tee off (Men from BLUE tees, Women from RED tees) and play their next shot and each subsequent shot from the best location, through the hole.
2. Each player's drive must be used a minimum of 3 times in the 18 holes.
3. If you do not have a complete foursome, continue to rotate shots in an alternate fashion as if there were a fourth player. If your group has only three players, each player's drive must be used a minimum of 4 times in the 18 holes.
4. NO gimmies will be allowed. Ball must be played thru the hole (even players of Bruiser Beach's skill level miss short putts now and then).
5. Each player will have ONE (and only one) "mulligan" to use for the 18 holes. It can be used on any shot in an effort to improve the team's score.
6. Please replace all divots, fix ball marks, rake the bunkers and keep play moving, as we have two groups starting on some holes. If (when) the ball goes into the water or woods, please take only a quick look and continue. Do not spend time looking for the Gnome... if your shot is lousy enough that you DO happen to find her, pick her up and take her with you. When you finish your round, present her to Doc Vogel and you will get your cash reward. We will then make a ruling on her demise!
7. Ball may be played from within one club length of the ball that is selected, no closer to the hole. This does not apply to putts.
8. If your ball is putted into a water hazard, throw putter into water, quit golfing, buy a bass boat and take up fishing.
9. Only one "skill" prize per player. If you are eligible for more than one, you don't belong here anyway!
10. Two free drink tickets will be provided to each player which are good for ANY drink and will be in an envelope in your cart. Please show the beverage cart attendants that we are a great bunch of people... tip them generously for their service!
11. Beer (Lakefront Brewery's finest!) will be available on the patio at take-off, at the turn and afterwards, until it is gone. Then you are on your own! Please drink responsibly and arrange for a designated driver, if need be.
